SS Lane Victory

Want to know about history? Want to find out about real patriotism? Then visit the **SS Lane Victory** on the San Pedro Waterfront.

The Lane Victory was built in 1945 in Los Angeles Harbor and served through the Vietnam War transporting troops and cargo around the world.

During the Korean War the Lane Victory evacuated more than 7,000 civilians from the active war zone. It was crewed by Merchant Marines and Navy Armed Guard members. Merchant Marines had the highest proportion of casualties of any service branch during World War II.

Today Lane Victory is a museum and memorial honoring the U.S. Merchant Marine and telling the story of Victory ships, LA Harbor, and more. There are two museums on board, built into the cargo holds. And the crew cabins are nearly identical to the ship's active sailing days. **SS Lane Victory**, Berth 49, 3600 Miner Street, Waterfront. 310-519-9545, www.TheLaneVictory.org.

LOS ANGELES WORLD CRUISE TERMINAL—Most cruises from San Pedro sail from the World Cruise Terminal. (Occasionally cruises will dock at Berth 43 at the Outer Harbor.)

To reach the World Cruise Terminal from throughout Southern California, travel to Interstate 110 (Harbor Freeway) southbound and follow it to southbound State Route 47. Exit at Harbor Blvd. (exit 1C).

For arrivals or departures from Berth 43, follow Harbor Blvd. southbound. It becomes Miner Street after passing 22nd Street. Continue southbound on Miner Street halfway around the circle. Enter at the gate for Berth 43.

Whether parking or dropping off or picking up passengers, enter the Cruise Terminal on Swinford Street and follow the signs for the appropriate berth or to enter the parking lot. You can drop off passengers and luggage at the lower levels and return to the parking lot to leave your vehicle.

There is plenty of parking for passengers who drive in to their embarkation. The first hour is free and \$2 thereafter, up to a maximum of \$18 per day for standard vehicles.

Or you can choose one of the park-and-cruise packages available at one of our recommended hotels. These hotels offer accommodation, parking, and transportation directly to and from the World Cruise Terminal for guests. We recommend the DoubleTree by Hilton San Pedro-Port of Los Angeles Hotel, Best Western Plus San Pedro Hotel & Suites, the Vagabond Inn, and Terranea Resort.

The World in Miniature

Belmont Shore RR Club Open House November 16 & 17



Belmont Shore Railroad Club is known as having one of the best model railroad layouts in the world. And it would be difficult, if not impossible, to replicate it. It's not just the space, occupying a full second floor of a former Army building at Angels Gate Park, but also the labor and love that the club members have put into the amazingly realistic N scale landscapes.

The club will have an open house on Saturday, November 16 and Sunday, November 17 starting at 10 a.m. and running until 4 p.m. each day. Plus, on Saturday will be a model railroad swap meet starting at 8 a.m. that's free to both buyers and sellers.

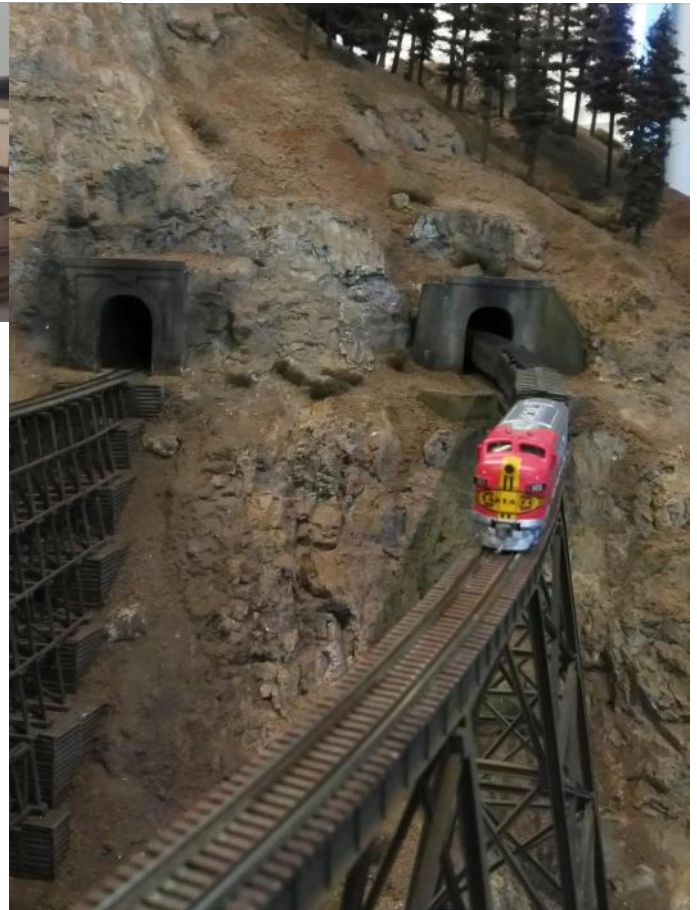
You'll get to see all the trains operating and talk to the people who continue to make the layout grow.

One of the most exciting developments for locals is the section that depicts Los Angeles Harbor (photo above). The warehouses are look identical to the historic structures still standing in the harbor. And they're even building Warehouse One, the historic building cruise passengers and boaters see when entering and exiting the harbor's Main Channel.

The Belmont Shore Railroad Club layout and its elements are mostly built from scratch.

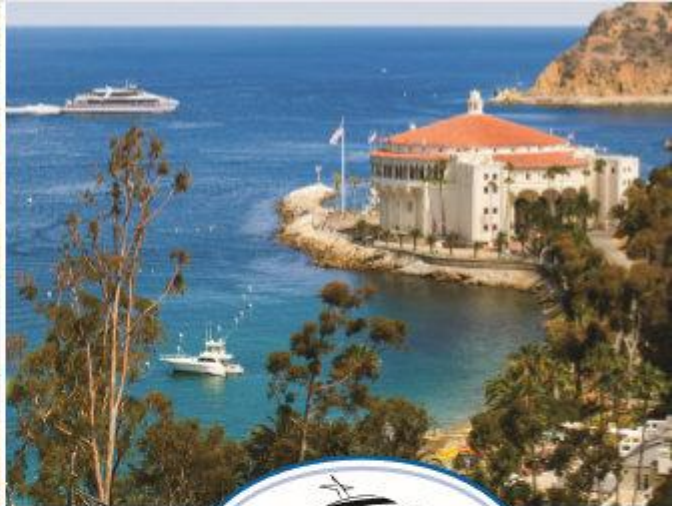

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
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

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Guide to Getting Around

Find your way around San Pedro—and all of LA.

There are lots of ways to get around.

The Historic Downtown is within walking distance of the San Pedro Waterfront or you can take the trolley on weekends.

The Downtown Trolley operates on weekends between the Cruise Terminal, 6th and 7th Streets, and Pacific Avenue, CRAFTED at the Port of Los Angeles, SS Lane Victory, and a stop at Battleship Iowa.

DASH buses operate on routes throughout the greater San Pedro area, south as far as 25th Street and west to Western Avenue.

Commuter Express line 142 has direct service to the Downtown Long Beach Transit Gallery where you can catch the Blue Line train that travels to downtown Los Angeles and connects to most rail lines that run throughout the greater Los Angeles area. Catch it at on the Waterfront or at stops along 7th Street and Gaffey Street north of 7th Street. (Note: the Blue Line is undergoing reconstruction and stops at the Rosa Parks Station. Buses are available to continue its route to Downtown Los Angeles.

Metro Transit buses operate several lines into, out of, and around San Pedro, mainly along 7th Street, Pacific Avenue, and Gaffey Street (although other streets are also served).

Connections to **Metrorail** are available from Downtown Los Angeles's Metro Center and some buses stop at rail stations along their routes.

The **Palos Verdes Transit Authority** provides bus services around the Palos Verdes Peninsula, to San Pedro, and as far north and west as Redondo Beach

Metro Bike Share

Offering bike rentals (with lots of free options). Eleven bike share stations in the Harbor area.

Lime Bikes and Electric Scooters

Look for the green bikes on many corners throughout San Pedro. Use your smartphone to unlock the bike. First ride is free.
